Preparation of Revised Smart City Proposal for Kota city in progress

Background and importance of citizen engagement

Under Smart City Mission, Ministry of Urban Development of Govt. of India has identified 100 potential smart cities. In the first round of this Mission, Govt. of India has selected 20 cities. Now remaining 80 cities, including Kota Nagar Nigam (KNN), have initiated the process of revision of Smart City Proposal for the second round. The Citizen's response and feedback for revision of the Smart City Proposal is important.

Retrofitting of an area- most preferred typology

Major component of this proposal is Area based Development, under which Govt. of India's focus is on retrofitting of an area of minimum 500 acres. Retrofitting of an area means improving an area by provision of adequate civic facilities and services, ensuring open spaces and recreational areas; proper road network with good transportation facilities; promote tourism, economic and commercial activities with mixed use development; protection and conservation of water bodies; adequate education and health facilities etc. The area chosen for retrofitting shall be such that it is replicable pilot area, it shall have ongoing/ proposed projects and it should benefit all sections of the society.

In the first list of 20 selected cities in Round -I, 18 cities have opted for retrofitting as the typology for Area based Development. A snapshot of key features of top three (3) cities area based development proposal is given in the figure 1.

Figure 1 Top 3 ranked cities key positives

Top 3 ranked cities – key positives

Bhubaneswar

- + **Retrofit area : 985 acre**
- + **Components: lake development, institutional area dev., economic activity, skill dev.**
- + Detailed financial plan (incl. a very extensive PPP plan)
- + Strong articulation of role of different departments; convergence of schemes

Pune

- + **Retrofit area : 900 acre**
- + **Components: socio economic development, public transportation, river conservation, education and hospital area dev., economic activity, skill dev.**
- + **Strong linkage and integration across SCP components; consultative rigor**
- + Rs. 1000 crore buffer funding from land monetisation; risk mitigation for financial plan

Jaipur

- + **Retrofit area : 600 acre**
- + **Components: basic infra. and services, economic activity, tourism etc.**
- + Sharp Thematic focus on Tourism and heritage
- + Strong detailing of Revenue generation for meeting O&M costs

What Revised Proposal Should Focus on?

Kota Nagar Nigam therefore, shall focus on selecting and finalising an area for retrofitting which shall comprise of following

- ❖ Should focus on key socio-economic activity of the city along with improvement of manageable area- it should not be very large area
- ❖ Focus should be on areas having potential for tourism, economic activity
- ❖ Focus should be on water conservation, water body development (if available), recreational areas and gardens
- ❖ Area shall have some identified projects which are planned/ in pipeline with a scope of convergence of funds

Are selected based on above criteria will be a scalable model which can be replicated in other parts of the city.

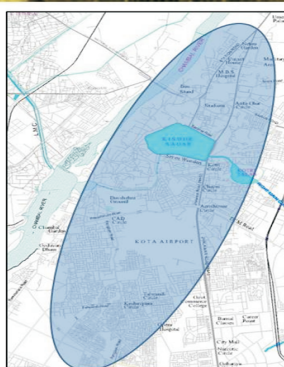

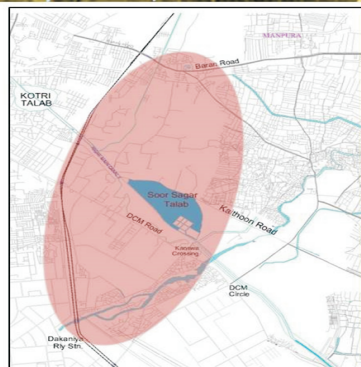
Figure 2 Options for area to be selected under Area based Development

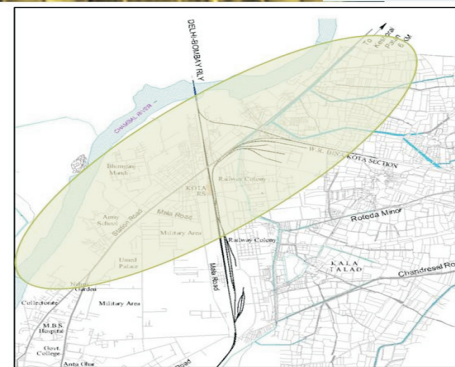

नगर निगम कोटा द्वारा चलाए गए विशेष पॉलिथिन जब्त अभियान रिपोर्ट

नगर निगम कोटा द्वारा विशेष पॉलिथिन एवं चाइनीज मॉझा जब्ती अभियान के अन्तर्गत 13055 किलो पॉलिथिन तथा चाइनीज मॉझा 2192 किलो जब्त किया गया। जिसमें निरन्तर जन जागरुक हेतु स्कूली बच्चों, व्यापारिक संगठनों, स्वयं सेवी संस्थाओं, कोचिंग व मेस संचालको के साथ बैठक कर विस्तृत कार्य योजना बनायी गयी। नगर निगम कोटा द्वारा पॉलिथिन रोकथाम के लिए उठाये गये कदम निम्नानुसार है:

- ❖ पॉलिथिन को प्रतिबंधित करने के लिए शहर में 40 होर्डिंग्स लगाये गये।
- ❖ पॉलिथिन का उपयोग नहीं करे इसके लिए 20 हजार संकल्प पत्र दैनिक भास्कर ने अभियान के साथ शहर वासियों से भरवाये गये।
- ❖ विभिन्न व्यापारिक संगठनों एवं संस्थानों की समझाईश की गई तथा पॉलिथिन प्रतिबन्ध पर सहयोग की अपील की गयी।
- ❖ सागर मित्र स्वयं सेवी संगठन द्वारा बच्चों को पॉलिथिन का उपयोग नहीं करने का संकल्प दिलाया।
- ❖ जिला कलेक्टर महोदय द्वारा बच्चों की होम-वर्क बुक में पॉलिथिन परिवार के सदस्य उपयोग न करें के नोट लिखने के आदेश दिये गये।
